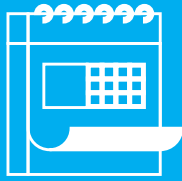


What is Collective Impact?

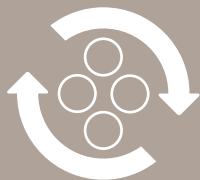

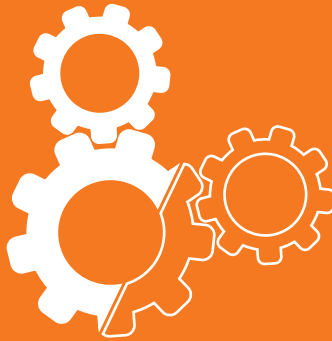
Backbone

Backbone support is a precondition for collective impact where a backbone organization must maintain a delicate balance between the strong leadership needed to keep all parties together and the invisible ‘behind the scenes’ role that lets stakeholders own the initiative’s success. As the backbone organization, Sageesse and the Sageesse Board of Directors are fiscally accountable for the provincial collective impact initiative, providing infrastructure and oversight of collective resources including supervision and financial accountability for staff and contractors while ensuring that we stay rooted in our core beliefs about our role as community mobilizers.
